



Village Prevala

Prevala is a ski resort and touristic village which approximately is 30 km away from Prizren, Kosovo and about twelve kilometers from Brezovica, the largest ski center in Kosovo. Prevala (Prevalac) is a popular destination for hikers or skiers. The village borders a large forest. During the summer, people go there to relax and rest, whereas during the winter people visit it for its seasonal recreational sports. It lies 1800m above sea level. Prevala (Prevalac) is located in the south of Kosovo in the Shar Mountains, in the road that leads from Prizren via Prevala to Shterpce (Strpce). The region belongs to the Shar Mountain National Park.

Prevala is known for its mixture of continental and Mediterranean climate. Many visitors come to the village and stay longer for healing reasons as the air is known to be therapeutic for a number of diseases including respiratory and other diseases.
